CHS AROUND THE STATE



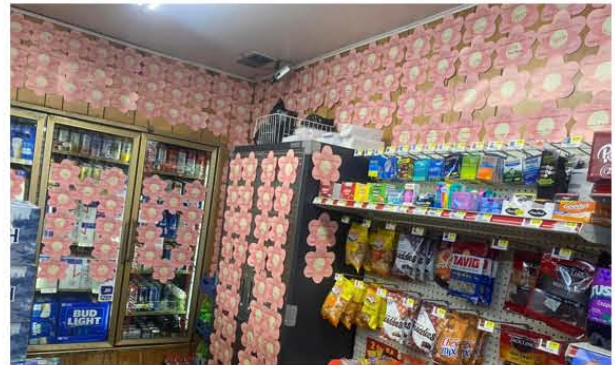
Last week, Our Charleston location celebrated Founder's Day! We also had a volunteer group from WVSU who helped to organize the resource room!
