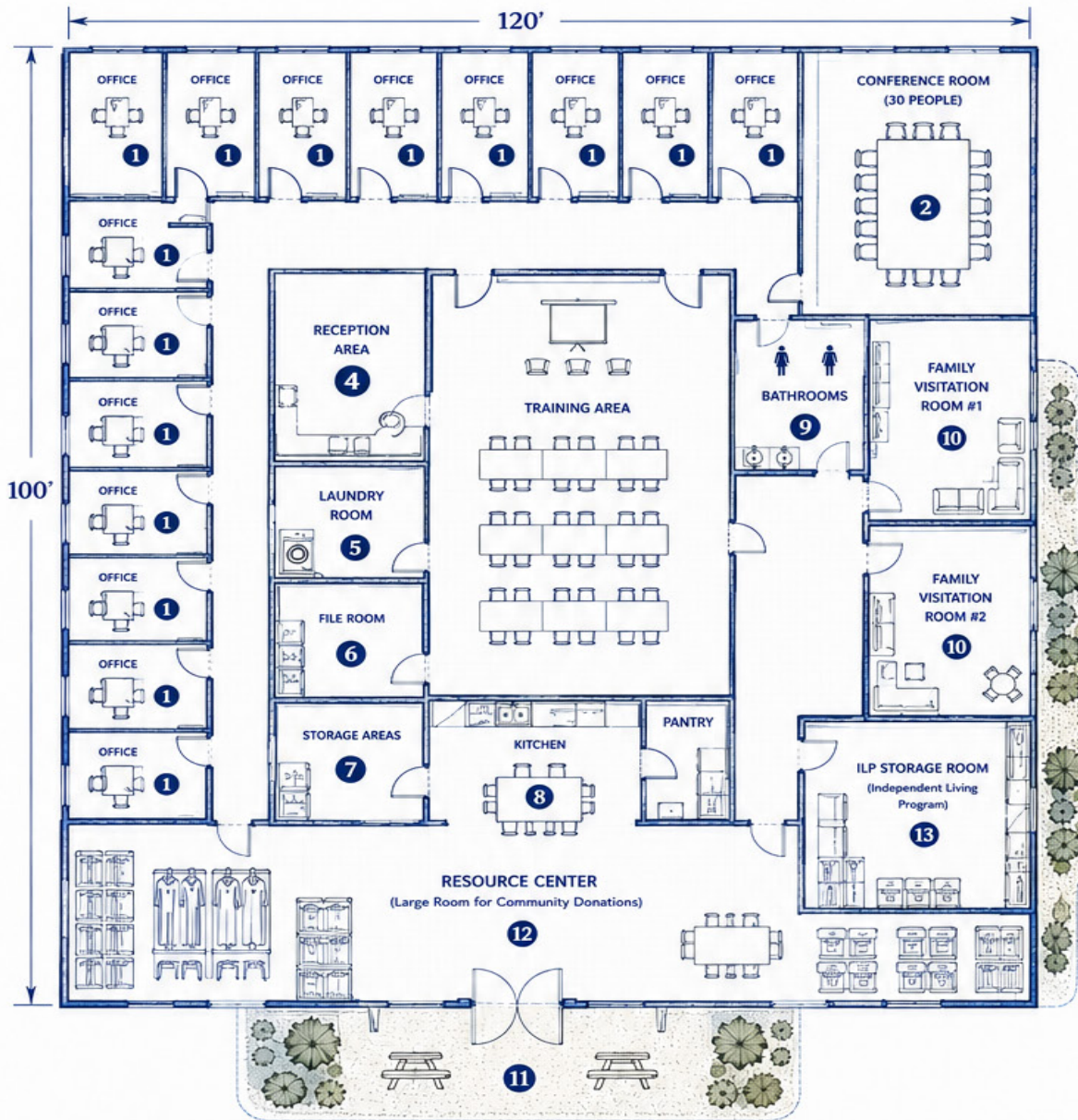

Why We Need *a New Home*

Our work is growing—and so is the need for a space that allows us to serve our children, families, and community with dignity, privacy, and excellence.



- 1 20 OFFICE SPACES**
Private office spaces for staff.
- 2 CONFERENCE ROOM**
Seats a minimum of 30 people.
- 3 TRAINING AREA**
For staff, foster families, and healthy grandfamily trainings.
- 4 RECEPTION AREA**
Room for at least two people waiting.
- 5 LAUNDRY ROOM**
Washer and dryer for donated items and Independent Living life skills.
- 6 FILE ROOM**
Large, secure storage for confidential client files.
- 7 STORAGE AREAS**
Multiple storage areas and closets throughout.
- 8 KITCHEN**
With pantry space, room for 2 refrigerators, freezer, and seating area.
- 9 BATHROOMS**
Multiple bathrooms for staff, clients, and community members.
- 10 FAMILY VISITATION ROOMS**
Two private spaces, large enough for multiple people with games and activities.
- 11 OUTDOOR AREA**
Safe, welcoming outdoor space for family visitation.
- 12 RESOURCE CENTER**
Large room for community donations and essential items.
- 13 ILP STORAGE ROOM**
Large room for Independent Living Program household items.
